



## ATTENTION RESIDENTS, FAMILIES, STAFF AND FRIENDS

We received confirmation from Huron Perth Public Health that as of 12:01 a.m., on Monday, November 16, Huron Perth Public Health Unit region will be in the YELLOW-PROTECT level of the provincial COVID-19 response framework. This directive is being implemented as a result of widespread transmission and infection within the larger community.

The Yellow – Protect level of the Keeping Ontario Safe & Open Framework provides strengthened public health measures and requires that Goderich Place implement the following additional measures immediately:

- All visitation will cease – no indoor or outdoor guests are permitted at this time;
- Residents are permitted only one essential visitor at this time – a healthcare provider or person assisting with care;
- Residents are no longer permitted to leave for short absences and temporary absences, except those required for healthcare purposes (i.e., medical appointments);
- Residents are permitted outside on the Goderich Place property and we encourage you to do so while practicing social distancing.

Please note that our dining room will remain open and activities will continue in groups of ten until further notice. We will be accepting deliveries to the front door and loading dock only, all other building access points will remain locked so that we can carefully monitor activity for contact tracing purposes.

We ask that you continue to be diligent and follow directions from public health officials by washing your hands with warm water and soap frequently, remaining physically distanced at all times and wearing a mask when in the company of anyone outside our bubble. Please arrange for your essentials to be delivered to Goderich Place at this time; contact a member of our staff if you have any questions about how to arrange a delivery.

These new measures are being implemented at the direction of government and health authorities to decrease the possibility of the virus spreading into Goderich Place. We thank you in advance for your attention, support and patience.
