An update to let you know our team continues to await direction from local health authorities on when COVID 19 testing will take place at Goderich Place. We expect to hear in the coming weeks and will share the date as soon as we're informed.

Regardless of the outcome it will still be several weeks before we begin easing the outbreak measures and so I'm asking again for your continued support in following the physical distancing measures put in place by the government. Our community remains the most at risk of all demographics and without a vaccine or treatment we can't be too safe.

To help break up the days ahead and allow more opportunities for connection, we're inviting groups of three people to participate in an outside social with our activation staff. I hope you will take advantage of, these outings and get a breath of fresh air. Michelle will reach out to invite residents, there is no need to sign up in advance. Hallway bingo and all other activities, including our Friday parades will continue three times a week. We'll also continue offering FaceTime calls for residents and their families. We can't yet commit to when our outbreak measures will be lifted but I can say that we've planned our approach with guidance from health and government experts and will share details with you in an upcoming communication. Please bear with us as we continue putting the health and safety of all residents and employees at the forefront.
