IMPORTANT: Masking Requirements in Retirement Homes

RHRA would like to remind all homes that <u>Directive #3</u>, the <u>Policy to Implement</u>
<u>Directive #3</u> and the Chief Medical Officer of Health's <u>Class Order</u> are still in effect.

This means that masking continues to be required for all residents in common areas of the home if physical distancing cannot be maintained and the resident does not have a medical exemption.

Below are references to masking requirements under the Policy to Implement Directive #3 that all homes are required to follow:
