We are very pleased to announce that Goderich Place has been declared "out of outbreak"!!

I'm sure you share the same sense of relief that all persons infected with this virus have recovered well. This has been in large part due everyone's strict compliance with the directives and vaccine mandates set by public health and Goderich Place retirement. This outbreak was particularly concerning because of the number of staff and residents that were infected in such a short period of time.

For us to move forward and to help prevent future outbreaks we are asking that all residents, staff and family members where a mask on site at all times. Wearing a mask while not on the property is also highly recommended while at appointments, shopping or visiting family. Washing your hands or sanitizing your hands consistently is also strongly recommended.
