Effective June 9th

The current provincial roadmap to reopen has some updates to retirement homes. Please keep in mind we are following the directives and changes as they come out by the Ontario Retirement Communities Association daily.

Goderich Place will take all necessary steps and controls measures to assist in the prevention and monitoring of COVID-19. Additionally, all visitors must agree to abide by the health and safety practices contained in directive #3 as a condition of entry into the residence. Public Health measures must be practiced at all times regardless of whether or not an individual has received a COVID-19 vaccine. This includes wearing a mask and goggles/face shield at all times other than for residents to have brief physical contact with their visitor for a hug. This includes no eating or drinking with resident where the mask would need to be removed.

All visitors must be screened and pass a pan bio rapid antigen test on Monday or Thursday before entering the building. We test on Monday and Thursday 9:15-12:30 and 1:30-3:45 at which time you will be provided an entry card to screen into the resident's suites for a 1-hour visit with 2 people at a time only. This will be done on a weekly basis. Visits will take place in the residents' room not in any common areas. Please keep in mind that the resident is allowed to leave the facility for social reasons if the party is larger.

No visitors will be permitted if a resident is in isolation or if the home is in an outbreak

The residents of Goderich Place will now be assessed for covid-19 symptoms once daily (not twice). This will include a temperature check every morning.

Please be patient as new rules and regulations become available.

For those residents who drive please be aware I have applied for all beach parking passes/permits. Permits are electronic and do not require a paper copy for proof and they are all in place, this goes by your licence plate and they are all now registered.
