As many of you already are aware, we are out of outbreak.

We would like to thank all staff and managers for their hard work. Thank you to all of the staff that worked extra hours to keep our residents safe!

Unfortunately, the number of positive Covid 19 cases are climbing again and as such, many LTC and Retirement homes in the province are in an outbreak. We need everyone's help in assisting us to keep Goderich Place covid free. We are asking everyone to diligently follow the public health measures when visiting our retirement community. Masking will continue to be required at all times within the building. Utilize hand sanitizers and socially distance yourself when you are not eating or drinking. Continued rapid testing is still required upon entry to our facilities for everyone. We are asking visitors to go directly to a resident's room, or designated visiting area upon receiving our negative test. Visiting residents in our common areas will not be allowed until further notice.

Group activities will be cancelled until further notice; small group activities will be allowed.
