Covid Memo To Residents, Families, Friends, and Staff

Despite our effort and Covid vaccine booster last month, we have cases of covid in our community. Public Health has declared us in outbreak.

This means that residents with symptoms will be isolated. We would ask that only essential visitors, visit those who are in isolation. Residents who have two or more symptoms will be PCR tested by nursing staff. I remind residents and family that we are following new directives and not using Rapid testing.

For those who have tested positive they will be in isolation for 10 days. Activities for residents in isolation may continue For Example 1:1 walks in an empty hallway or outside with appropriate PPE

At this time activities, and dining will continue for those residents who are asymptomatic.

We will be increasing our efforts and working with public health to stop the spread and be out of outbreak as quickly as we can. We will be monitoring all resident for symptoms twice a day.

Please help us stop the spread and only visit when you are feeling well, and continue to wear a mask at all times.
