



## ATTENTION RESIDENTS, FAMILIES, STAFF AND FRIENDS

As you are likely now aware, the provincial government has ordered a strict lockdown for the entire province of Ontario. The lockdown will begin December 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:01 a.m., and last until January 23<sup>rd</sup> for all regions in southern Ontario. During the lockdown only essential businesses will be allowed to remain open. No indoor public events or social gatherings will be allowed, except with members of the same household.

In accordance with this direction all in person, on property visitation will cease as of December 26<sup>th</sup> for 28 days. Please note the exceptions:

- Essential support workers, including regulated and unregulated health professionals are permitted;
- A maximum of one caregiver may visit a resident at one time; should two caregivers live together they may visit a resident at the same time.

Residents are permitted to leave Goderich Place for essential visits only. Medical, dental, pharmaceutical etc. We are highly recommending that you arrange delivery for all personal items during this time. Please avoid going out anywhere. Grocery and pharmaceuticals can all be delivered here to Goderich Place. Any items from family members can be delivered to our front door and we will have them sanitized and delivered to residents directly.

Given the lockdown will mean no family and friend visits, we will also set up a more robust FaceTime schedule, please contact our onsite activation manager to ensure yours are scheduled.

Please note that our dining room will remain open and activities will continue until further notice.
